Second Season of Polo in the Park Coming Soon

LEESBURG, VA – Morven Park is excited to announce that the *Polo in the Park* arena polo series is returning to the Park's International Equestrian Center starting June 30. Visitors are invited to the Park for two arena polo matches, picnicking, and dancing every Saturday evening for eight consecutive weeks this summer.

"We're thrilled to offer polo to the community again this summer," said Sheryl Williams, Morven Park's Executive Director. "Last year's inaugural season proved to be a fun, can't-miss event for Loudoun County, and we're excited to build on that success this year."

After its hugely popular first season of polo, during which the Park welcomed over 7,000 spectators, Morven Park is planning to make *Polo in the Park* even more enjoyable, thanks to its returning sponsors and new partners. This year, Morven Park is partnering with Certified Master Chef Rich Rosendale's local Roots 657 restaurant throughout the season. Roots will be serving favorites from its menu, including pulled pork and burgers, every night of polo this summer. Another popular Loudoun County restaurant, King Street Oyster Bar, will bring its Oyster Truck to the Park for five nights of polo as well. Stone Tower Winery — the Official Wine Sponsor of *Polo in the Park* — will return to offer wine for sale by the glass or bottle. The community is invited to follow Morven Park on Facebook for updates on weekly food vendors, menus, and special dessert offerings.

Each night of the season will include two arena polo matches, with the first starting at 7:00 p.m. and the second starting at approximately 8:30 p.m. The matches will feature skilled polo players from around the world, including internationally-renowned players Juan Salinas-Bentley and Doug Barnes. The sport is thrilling to watch, for longtime fans and new spectators alike, with nonstop action in the arena during each match.

Spectators are encouraged to picnic and enjoy their beverage of choice on the terraced viewing area next to the arena. During the intermission between the first and second matches, kids of all ages will be invited into the arena for fun games, including the popular tug-of-war. Visitors can top off the evening with dancing in the pavilion tent immediately following the final polo match each night.

General Admission car passes will be available for purchase at www.PoloInThePark.org beginning Monday, May 28. Car passes will be \$35 when purchased in advance, or \$40 at the gate (cash sales only). Purchasing car passes in advance is strongly recommended. Tailgate spots and box seating along the arena rail are currently on sale. Email Polo@morvenpark.org for availability and pricing.
