General Information

The Morven Park Arena Driving Trial is recognized by the American Driving Society and every class offered herein which is covered by the current rules and specifications of the Society will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Indoor arena will host the dressage & obstacle course. Cones will take place in outdoor arena, weather permitting.

Entries: Entries open February 2 and close March 2, 2014. ADT entry fee is \$65 for the day (Dressage/cones/obstacles), plus separate check for ADS competitor fee of \$5 (members) or \$30 (non-members). Post entry fee is \$85. Mail entries to show secretary:

Required with ADS Combined Driving Event entry form & waiver, please include a negative Coggins within 12 months of event date, 2014 Morven Park Hold Harmless form and payment. All correspondence from secretary will be via email. More than one equine per driver may be accommodated if entries allow. If sending in multiple entries, please indicate which entry is the primary one in case only one is accepted. Show secretary has the right to accept or refuse entries. Fully complete entries are given priority.

Refunds: Before closing date – entry & stabling less \$25 non-refundable office fee. After closing date – no refund, unless there is a wait-list and an entry can be found to fill the spot – then refund less \$25 office fee. No refunds (entry or stabling) after March 3. Please make checks payable to Morven Park.

Scratches/Changes must be in writing via mail, fax, and email only.

Stabling: Permanent stalls will be available beginning Saturday afternoon at 2:00 pm. Stall fees are \$40 per night; shavings available for purchase at \$10/bag. All stabling requests must have a stabling form submitted to the Secretary by closing date. Stalls will **not** need to be stripped.

Accommodations: (Ask for Morven Park Rate)

Best Western – 2 miles, 1-800-528-1234; Holiday Inn, 1-888-850-8545; Hampton Inn & Suites 703-669-8640; Comfort Suites, 703-669-1650. Self-contained RV/Trailer Campers only – no dumping of grey water, limited hookups. No electric or water hookups are permitted from barns; no tent sites; no sleeping in barns.

Directions:

Address: 41793 Tutt Lane, Leesburg, VA 20176 (North of Leesburg off Route 15)

From North: Right on Route 740 – Tutt Lane (1 miles north of town, just before Leesburg bypass) – 8/10 miles to drive on left.

From South: Left on Route 740 – Tutt Lane (200 yards after end of Leesburg bypass) – 8/10 mile to drive on left. **DO NOT** follow signs in Leesburg for “Morven Park”. See directions to Morven Park Equestrian Center (Tutt Lane entrance) at www.morvenpark.org.

Other Information:

Cross-country course will not be open for driving during or after the event. Dogs must be leashed at all times while on grounds. Absolutely no motorized vehicles permitted in barns. Grilling or campfires are strictly prohibited anywhere on grounds. Food will be available for purchase at the Morven Park Café for breakfast and lunch.

Schedule:

- Show Secretary will be open on Saturday after 2:00 pm until 5:00 pm, and 7:00 am Sunday morning.
- Dressage will begin promptly at 8:30 in the Indoor Arena.
- Cones course will be driven immediately after dressage in the outdoor Davis Arena, weather permitting. Order of go is the same as dressage.
- Cones course will be available for walking Sunday morning. Once dressage begins, the cones course will close for walking.
- Obstacles will be set in the Indoor Arena after all dressage tests have been driven. A short briefing will be provided to explain the obstacle competition. Competitors will have approximately 30 minutes following the briefing to walk the obstacles. Diagrams will be available in show packets.

Divisions and Awards:

- Classes will be offered as follows: S/H, S/P, VSE (Single & Multiple), Multiples, and Intermediate.
- There are three divisions offered: Training, Preliminary and Intermediate. A minimum of four entries are required for each class, or Show Organizer reserves the right to combine classes. Dressage tests will be ADS/ADT: Training #1, Preliminary #1, and Intermediate #1.
- Six ribbons will be awarded in each division.
- Best Training dressage, Best Preliminary Dressage & Best Intermediate Dressage awards will be given.
- An award for best “young driver” (under 18 yrs.) will be given.

Turnout, Attire and Appointments:

- Any turnout deemed unsafe by the Judge will not be allowed to compete.
- Dress is marathon casual (neat and appropriate for weather), as per ADS ADT rules.
- Helmets are required for anyone on a carriage at all times, including dressage.
- A bridle with a rein attached and passed through the saddle terrets must be in place whenever put to a vehicle. Failure to comply will result in elimination. The horse must never be left unattended while put to a vehicle.
- St. Patty's decorations encouraged!

Venue:

- Dressage will take place in the indoor arena, warm up in the small indoor. Competitors will be allowed to circle the dressage ring once before starting the test.
- Obstacles may be driven twice provided time allows.
- For groom requirements, see ADS rulebook. Anyone riding on a carriage at any time **must** sign waiver and wear protective headgear.
- All ADS rules and regulations apply
- Any changes/announcements/scores will be posted on the bulletin board located at the Indoor Arena.

Morven Park is excited to host carriage driving events at this wonderful venue. Significant improvements are planned throughout the property as part of our capital campaign, which will ultimately allow us to offer a variety of carriage events in 2014 and beyond. EQUESTRIAN RENTAL AGREEMENT / HOLD HARMLESS

This Equestrian Rental Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2014 (valid through December 31, 2014) by and between Westmoreland Davis Memorial Foundation, Inc. (hereinafter "MORVEN PARK") and _____ (hereinafter "User"). (Your Name)

WHEREAS, MORVEN PARK has agreed to confer to USER the non-exclusive possession and use of the facilities identified as _____ (Location: _____), subject to the terms of this Agreement, for the purpose of participating in one or more of the following activities: Dressage, Combined Training, Hunter/Jumper, Foxhunting, Organized Trail Rides, and/or Driving Events.

THEREFORE BE IT AGREED:

USER shall be entitled to use the above referenced facilities and participate in the aforementioned horse related activities for each day that a rental fee is paid. This Agreement shall remain valid and binding on USER for a period of one (1) year from the date of execution of this Agreement or until this Agreement is superseded by a new Equestrian Rental Agreement signed by USER, whichever is later.

The USER acknowledges the inherent risk involved in riding and working around horses, such risks include, but is not limited to (i) bodily injury from using, riding, or being in close proximity to horses, (ii) injury to both riders and horses in normal use or in competition and schooling, (iii) the propensity of a horse to behave in dangerous ways which may result in injury to persons, rider, trainer, groom or handler, (iv) the inability to predict a horse's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons or animals, (v) hazards of surface or subsurface conditions and riding over unknown terrain where hazards may be hidden by vegetation or conditions, (vi) collisions with other animals or objects, and (vii) the potential of a participant (amateur or professional) or bystander acting in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the horse or not acting within the participant's ability.

The USER further acknowledges that riding, cross-country horseback riding, jumping and foxhunting (which include riding over fences, other obstacles, and steep and rough terrain) are inherently dangerous activities. Despite the inherent dangers associated with riding and working around horses, the USER wishes to participate in the above referenced horse related activities.

The USER understands that a parent, legal guardian or other adult **must** accompany him/her if the USER is under the age of 16 years.

The USER agrees to read and abide by the Rules and Regulations of Morven Park. The USER acknowledges and understands that the Rules and Regulations are deemed to be part of this Agreement.

In exchange for being permitted to participate in the above mentioned horse related activities, the USER, his/her heirs, guardians, and legal representatives, **releases, hold harmless, indemnifies and exonerates the Westmoreland Davis Memorial Foundation, Inc., its masters, officers, directors, members, employees, or guests or any landowners, landholders or the persons making Morven Park property available to the USER from any and all liability, loss, cost or expense including reasonable attorneys' fees rising out of any suit based on any accident or injury, (including death), of the USER and of the USER's property in or about Morven Park, whether or not caused by the negligence of anyone on Morven Park property arising out of the USER's participation in the above mentioned horse related activities.** The provisions within this document shall survive the expiration of this Agreement.

The USER's signature hereby indicates his/her agreement to wear a hard hat at all times while riding at Morven Park, to obey all rules set forth by MORVEN PARK in the Rules and Regulations, and allow Morven Park to use this information in mailings. This information will not be sold or shared. I further grant the Released Parties the right to photograph and/or videotape me and/or my child or ward and further to display, use and/or otherwise exploit my and/or my child or ward's name, face, likeness, voice, and appearance, in all media in all forms including, without limitation, digitized images, whether for advertising, publicity, or promotional purposes, including, without limitation, publication of Event results and standings, without compensation, reservation or limitation.
