

#### What are Horse Trials?

#### 50 years of eventing at Morven Park

Morven Park has hosted recognized Horse Trials since 1973, when the event was under the direction of cavalry master Major John Lynch and the Morven Park International Equestrian Institute.

Today, we are proud to continue this legacy and host the Morven Park Spring Horse Trials and the Morven Park International & Fall Horse Trials. As one of six venues in the United States to hold a CCI4\*-L competition, we invite competitors and spectators to enjoy the exciting, multi-phase discipline of eventing at all levels.

Have you ever wondered what would happen if a triathlon involved more moving parts? Welcome to the sport of eventing!

Like a triathlon, eventing (also called Horse Trials) features three different equestrian disciplines—dressage, show jumping, and cross-country. Each phase demonstrates the grace, bravery, and athleticism of the horse/rider combo, fully embracing the definition of a well-rounded athlete.





#### **DRESSAGE**

During the dressage test, horse and rider demonstrate their level of communication, relaxation, and harmony through a series of intricate movements.

**Best vantage point:** Anywhere outside the arena fence and away from the arena entrance.

**Spectator tips:** Horse and rider are in a state of concentration, so it is important to avoid distracting them. Please hold your applause until the rider makes a final halt and salutes the judge.



#### **SHOW JUMPING**

Over a course of 12–15 jumps that can easily be knocked down, horse and rider showcase their ability to think quickly on their feet. Horses may touch a rail without penalty, but if the rail falls, or if the horse refuses to jump, the rider receives four penalties per issue.

**Best vantage point:** Anywhere outside the arena fence and away from the arena entrance.

**Spectator tips:** Horse and rider are in a state of concentration, so please hold your applause until you see them cross the finish line.

#### **CROSS-COUNTRY**

Horses and riders put on their cross-country gear and test their bravery and athleticism over terrain featuring logs, ditches, embankments, and water obstacles. Depending on the level of competition, course lengths range from 2 to 4.5 miles, and are ridden at a gallop, with exact speed requirements for each level.

Best vantage point: Outside of the galloping tracks, there are jump judges and stewards throughout the course, and they'll gladly direct you to the safest spots for ideal viewing.

Spectator tips: Water jumps are very popular to watch, and oftentimes you are able to see several additional obstacles from the same viewing area.

It's safest to enter the cross-country course at the beginning of the competition or during breaks between different levels of competition. Listen for the announcer to indicate those breaks.

#### **Spectator Guide**

#### WHILE ON COURSE

- Please be careful not to provide unauthorized assistance to horses and riders on course as you may unwittingly cause their elimination.
- Unauthorized assistance: Giving directions, letting them know they've missed an obstacle, etc.
- Permitted assistance: Catching a loose horse, helping a rider remount after a fall, and handing a rider any part of their equipment while mounted or dismounted.
- Please watch out for groundhog holes! We have attempted to flag and fill them
  on and near the track of the cross-country course, the dressage arena, the
  show jumping arenas, and the designated warm-up arenas. However, these
  holes can reappear within hours of being filled and remain a hazard to riders
  and spectators alike. We cannot be held responsible for areas off the track of
  the course. Anyone spotting an unflagged hazard is requested to immediately
  advise an official.

## AND LAST BUT NOT LEAST...

- Dogs must be on a leash and attached to a person or an immovable object at all times. This is a USEF rule (GR 301.6) and failure to comply can result in penalties or elimination from the competition.
- Officials and jump judges have full authority, so please respect their requests.
- Horses and riders on course have the right-of-way, and the galloping track and the area around all marked obstacles must be kept clear at all times.
- The USEA rule pertaining to motorized vehicles on the cross-country course will be strictly enforced. Only official vehicles will be permitted.
- The Organizing Committee, the USEF, the Westmoreland Davis Memorial Foundation, and the Morven Park International Equestrian Center do not accept any liability for any accident, injury, theft or illness to horses, riders, owners, attendants, spectators, or any person or property whatsoever.
