<u>California Warm Up</u>: An unjudged warm-up class to be used one time, per horse/rider combination, before your hunter division of choice. *Will only run if time permits* 1. California Warm Up

Low Hunter: Open. No restrictions on riders. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences 2'3". BHSA Rated.

2&3. Low Hunter O/F 4. Low Hunter U/S

Schooling Hunter: Open. No restrictions on riders. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a Pony Division. Fences 2'6". BHSA rated.

5&6. Schooling Hunter O/F 7. Schooling Hunter U/S

T.I.P Thoroughbred Hunter presented by The Tack Box: Open to

thoroughbreds who are registered with, or are eligible to be registered with, the Jockey Club. Fences 2'6". May be combined with Green and/or Working Hunter in order to fill. BHSA/VHSA/TIP rated.

> 8&9. TB Hunter O/F 10. TB Hunter U/S

<u>Green Hunter</u>: Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences. May be combined with Thoroughbred and/or Working Hunter in order to fill. Fences 2'6". BHSA/VHSA rated.

11&12. Green Hunter O/F 13. Green Hunter U/S

Working Hunter: Open to horses. Fences at 3'. May be combined with Thoroughbred and/or Green Hunter in order to fill. BHSA/VHSA rated. 14&15. Working Hunter O/F 16. Working Hunter U/S

\$100 Total Equine Veterinary Associates Hunter Derby: Two rounds over fences with the top 10 being called back for a second handy hunter round. Open to horses & ponies. Fences 2'6" or 3'.

Adult Amateur riders on horses. Fences 2'6" or 3'. BHSA/VHSA rated. 18&19. AA Hunter O/F 20. AA Hunter U/S

McClain/CB Farm: Open to Adult Amateurs on horses or Juniors on horses or ponies. To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control and guidance. BHSA/VHSA rated.

Junior/Adult Amateur Equitation presented by Daniel & Kimberly Burke/Adare Show Hunters: Open to Junior and Adult

Amateur riders on horses only. Fences 2'6 or 3' The judge may select at least one quarter of the class to return to work on the flat. BHSA/VHSA rated.

Children's Hunter presented by CWD: Open to Junior riders on horses.

Leadline: Open to riders 7 & under. To be led at the walk. No cross entry into any trot classes. Judged 50/50 rider/suitability of mount. BHSA rated. 101. Leadline

Pre-Short Stirrup: Open to riders 10 & under. Riders may be asked to walk, trot & perform simple Equitation tasks. No cross entry into any canter or jumping classes. BHSA rated.

Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 13 & over. Fences at 18". Horses & Riders may only cross enter into Pleasure, Eq on the Flat & non-VHSA Assoc. classes. 111&112. LS Hunter O/F 113. LS Hunter U/S

Hunter Pleasure Pony: Open to Ponies 14.2 hands & under in hunter tack to be ridden by junior riders only. BHSA/VHSA rated. 114. Hunter Pleas. Pony W/T 115. Hunter Pleas. Pony GAYP 116. Hunter Pleas. Pony W/T/C Junior/Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse: Open to all horses in hunter tack ridden

by juniors and adults. Class will be split between juniors and adults if entries warrant. BHSA/VHAS rated.

Farm: Open to junior riders on ponies 14.2 hands & under to be shown over fences Sm 2'/Med 2'3"/ Large 2'6". The judge may select at least one quarter of the class to return to work on the flat. BHSA/VHSA rated. 123. Pony Equitation

Pony Hunter: Open to ponies 14.2 & under ridden by junior riders only. Fences Sm 2'/Med 2'3"/Large 2'6". May split Sm/Med & Large if entries warrant. BHSA/VHSA rated. 124&125. Pony Hunter O/F 126. Pony Hunter U/S

<u>Mini Hunter Derby</u>: Two rounds over fences with the top 10 being called back for a second handy hunter round. Open to horses & ponies ridden by juniors or amateurs. Fences at 2'. 127. Mini Hunter Derby

Series end awards and prizes will be given to the high point horse and/or rider for each division at the final show.

Derby finals (held on September 5th) will be open to the top 12 horses/ponies for the series and invitations will be emailed to each qualifying horse/pony owner. If one of the qualifying horses/ponies is unable to attend, another horse/pony <u>will not</u> be moved up the list.
