<u>California Warm Up:</u> An unjudged warm-up class to be used one time, per horse/rider combination, before your hunter division of choice. *Will only run if time permits*

1. California Warm Up

Low Hunter: Open. No restrictions on riders. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences 2'3".

2&3. Low Hunter O/F

4. Low Hunter U/S

Schooling Hunter: Open. No restrictions on riders. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a Pony Division. Fences 2'6".

5&6. Schooling Hunter O/F

7. Schooling Hunter U/S

T.I.P Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to thoroughbreds who are registered with, or are eligible to be registered with, the Jockey Club. Fences 2'6". May be combined with Green and/or Working Hunter in order to fill.

8&9. TB Hunter O/F

10. TB Hunter U/S

Green Hunter: Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences. May be combined with Thoroughbred and/or Working Hunter in order to fill. Fences 2'6".

11&12. Green Hunter O/F

13. Green Hunter U/S

Working Hunter: Open to horses. Fences at 3'. May be combined with Thoroughbred and/or Green Hunter in order to fill.

14&15. Working Hunter O/F

16. Working Hunter U/S

\$100 Coat Defense Hunter Derby: Two rounds over fences with the top 10 being called back for a second handy hunter round. Open to horses & ponies. Fences 2'6" or 3'.

17. Hunter Derby

Adult Amateur Hunter presented by Edward and Kathryn Harrell:

Adult Amateur riders on horses. Fences 2'6" or 3'.

18&19. AA Hunter O/F

VHSA Associate Junior/Adult Amateur Equitation on the Flat:

Open to Adult Amateurs on horses or Juniors on horses or ponies. To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control and guidance.

21. VHSA Equitation on the Flat

VHSA Associate Junior/Adult Amateur Equitation: Open to

Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses only. Fences 2'6 or 3' The judge may select at least one quarter of the class to return to work on the flat.

22. VHSA Associate Junior/Adult Amateur Equitation

Children's Hunter: Open to Junior riders on horses. Fences 2'6" or 3'.

Leadline presented by Rachel Howell & Quiet Haven Farm: Open

to riders 7 & under. To be led at the walk. No cross entry into any trot classes. Judged 50/50 rider/suitability of mount.

101. Leadline

<u>Pre-Short Stirrup:</u> Open to riders 10 & under. Riders may be asked to walk, trot & perform simple Equitation tasks. No cross entry into any canter or jumping classes.

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 12 & under. Fences at 18".

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 12 & under. Fences at 18". Horses & Riders may only cross enter into Pleasure, Eq on the Flat & non-VHSA Assoc. classes.

Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 13 & over. Fences at 18". Horses & Riders may only cross enter into Pleasure, Eq on the Flat & non-VHSA Assoc. classes.

<u>Hunter Pleasure Pony:</u> Open to Ponies 14.2 hands & under in hunter tack to be ridden by junior riders only.

Junior/Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse: Open to all horses in hunter tack ridden by juniors and adults. Class will be split between juniors and adults if entries warrant.

Hopeful Hunter presented by Katy Cowasjee: Open. No restrictions on riders. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 2'.

VHSA Associate Pony Equitation: Open to junior riders on ponies 14.2 hands & under to be shown over fences Sm 2'/Med 2'3"/ Large 2'6". The judge may select at least one quarter of the class to return to work on the flat.

123. VHSA Associate Pony EQ

Pony Hunter: Open to ponies 14.2 & under ridden by junior riders only. Fences Sm 2'/Med 2'3"/Large 2'6". May split Sm/Med & Large if entries warrant.

124&125. Pony Hunter O/F 126. Pony Hunter U/S

\$100 Total Equine Veterinary Associates Mini Hunter Derby: Two rounds over fences with the top 10 being called back for a second handy hunter round. Open to horses & ponies ridden by juniors or amateurs. Fences at 2'.

127. Hunter Derby

Series end awards and prizes will be given to the high point horse and/or rider for each division at the final show.

Derby finals (held on September 5th) will be open to the top 12 horses/ponies for the series and invitations will be emailed to each qualifying horse/pony owner. If one of the qualifying horses/ponies is unable to

attend, another horse/pony will not be moved up the list.
