CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

California Warm Up: An unjudged warm-up class to be used one time, per horse/rider combination, before your hunter division of choice. *Will only run if time permits*

Blue/Red Warm Up: A judged warm-up class to be used one time, per horse/rider combination, before your hunter division of choice.

Schooling Hunter: Open. No restrictions on riders. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a Pony Division. Fences 2'6".

T.I.P Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to thoroughbreds who are registered with, or are eligible to be registered with, the Jockey Club. Fences 2'6". May be combined with Low Working and/or Working Hunter in order to fill. VHSA/TIP rated.

Green Hunter: Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 2'6" and higher. May be combined with Low Working and/or Working Hunter in order to fill. Fences 2'6". VHSA Rated.

Low Working Hunter: Open to horse and ponies. May by combined with Green and/or Working Hunter in order to fill. Fences 2'9".

Working Hunter: Open to horses and ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences at 3'. May be combined with Low Working and/or Green Hunter in order to fill. VHSA rated.

Open Hunter Derby: Two rounds over fences with the top 10 being called back for a second handy hunter round. Open to horses & ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences 2'6" or 3'.

Child/Adult Amateur Hunter Derby: Two rounds over fences with the top 10 being called back for a second handy hunter round. Open to horses & ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateurs. Fences 2'6" or 3'.

Adult Amateur Hunter: Adult Amateur riders on horses. Fences 2'6" or 3'. VHSA rated.

Hopeful Hunter: Open. No restrictions on riders. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 2'.

Saturday Low Hunter: Open. No restrictions on riders. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences 2'3".

Sunday Low Hunter: Open. No restriction on riders. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences 2'6".

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Pony Hunter: Open to ponies 13.2 hands & under ridden by Junior riders only. Fences Small 2'/Medium 2'3"/Large 2'6". May combine Small/Medium & Large if entries warrant. VHSA rated.

Mini Hunter Derby: Two rounds over fences with the top 10 being called back for a second handy hunter round. Open to horses & ponies ridden by Juniors or Amateurs. Fences at 2'.

VHSA Children's Medal: Open to Junior members of VHSA. Riders may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3 feet, 3 inches (1.0m) with the exception of the Children's/Adult Jumper division, at the same show, where a rider may not jump higher than 3'9" (1.15m). Rider must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3. Open to horses only.

Children's Hunter: Open to Junior riders on horses. Fences 2'6" or 3'. VHSA rated.

Junior/Adult Equitation on the Flat: Open to Adult Amateurs on horses or Juniors on horses or ponies. To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control and guidance..

Leadline: Open to riders 7 & under. To be led at the walk. No cross entry into any trot classes. Judged on rider & suitability of mount.

Pre-Short Stirrup: Open to riders 10 & under. Riders may be asked to walk, trot & perform simple Equitation tasks. No cross entry into any canter or jumping classes.

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 12 & under. Fences at 18". Rider not allowed to cross enter classes where they jump higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Mini Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 12 & under. Fences at crossrails. Horses & riders may only cross enter Pleasure and Eq on the Flat.

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 12 & under. Fences at 18". Horses & Riders may only cross enter Pleasure, Eq on the Flat & non-VHSA Assoc. classes. VHSA rated.

Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 13 & over. Fences at 18". Horses & Riders may only cross enter into Pleasure, Eq on the Flat & non-VHSA Assoc. classes.

Hunter Pleasure Pony: Open to Ponies 14.2 hands & under in hunter tack to be ridden by junior riders only. VHSA rated.

Junior/Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse: Open to all horses in hunter tack ridden by juniors and adults. VHSA rated.

Open Jumper 1.20m: Open to horses and ponies. Fences not to exceed 1.20m.

Modified Jumper 1.10m: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences not to exceed 1.10m. VHSA rated.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Puddle Jumper .75m: Open to horses and ponies. Fences not to exceed .75m.

Mini Jumper 0.80m: Open to horses and ponies. Fences not to exceed 0.80m.

Thoroughbred Jumper/TIP Suitable Jumper 0.85m: Open to thoroughbreds who are registered with the Jockey Club. No restrictions on riders. Fences not to exceed 0.85m. VHSA/TIP rated.

Hopeful Jumper 0.85m: Open to horses and ponies. Fences not to exceed 0.85m

Low Jumper 0.9m: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences not to exceed 0.9m. VHSA rated.

Schooling Jumper 1.0m: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences not to exceed 1.0m. VHSA rated.

Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper 1.0m: Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateurs. Fences not to exceed 1.0m. VHSA rated.
