HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- All horses entering the competition grounds must present:
 - A current negative Coggins test dated within one (1) year of the final day of competition.
 - Proof of Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes Virus (Flu/Rhino) vaccination within six (6) months of the competition.
- Back numbers will not be issued until all required paperwork has been submitted and approved.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to utilize EquiTrace Event Pass for submission of required documentation. Hard copies should be available upon request.

DIRECTIONS

41580 Sunday Morning Lane
Leesburg, VA 20176

Morven Park's Equestrian Center is located one mile north of the Town of Leesburg off Route 15 on Route 740 (Tutt Lane). **From Washington, DC:** Take the Dulles Toll Road/Greenway (VA-267) West approximately 28 miles. Take exit 1B for US-15 N/VA-7 East toward Frederick, Md. Continue NORTH on US-15 N Bypass for about 3.5 miles. Following the light at Battlefield Parkway, the north-bound lanes will split from the south-bound lanes. Just after they merge again, enter the left turn lane to turn LEFT onto Tutt Lane (Route 740). Continue .5 mile to the Morven Park entrance on the LEFT. **Option from VA-7/Leesburg Pike:** Take VA-7 WEST toward Leesburg, exiting at US-15 N/Leesburg Bypass. Travel NORTH and continue to follow directions above. **From points west:** Take VA-7 EAST to US-15 N/Leesburg Bypass NORTH or take I-66 EAST or Route 50 EAST to US-15 NORTH. Take US-15/Leesburg Bypass NORTH. Following the light at Battlefield Parkway, the north-bound lanes will split from the south-bound lanes. Just after they merge again, enter the left turn lane to turn LEFT onto Tutt Lane (Route 740). Continue .5 mile to the Morven Park entrance on the LEFT. **From points north:** Take US-15 SOUTH toward Leesburg. After the light at White's Ferry Road/Raspberry Falls, watch for the third road on the right, Tutt Lane (Route 740). You will turn onto Tutt Lane just before the US-15 Business and US-15 Bypass split. Continue .5 mile to the Morven Park entrance on the left. **From Warrenton, VA. and points south:** From US-15 N/US-29 North, take James Madison Hwy./US-15 approximately 22 miles. At VA-7, turn right and continue on the ramp onto US-15 Bypass NORTH. Continue on US-15/Leesburg Bypass NORTH. Following the light at Battlefield Parkway, the north-bound lanes will split from the south-bound lanes. Just after they merge again, enter the left turn lane to turn LEFT onto Tutt Lane (Route 740). Continue .5 mile to the Morven Park entrance on the LEFT.

PARKING

- Please obey all posted park signage while on competition grounds.
- Trailer parking locations are indicated on the official show map and must be followed as designated.
- Passenger vehicles must park only in designated car parking areas.
- All trailer parking should be arranged with consideration for neighboring exhibitors. Please leave adequate space for safe access, loading, and exit, and do not obstruct drive lanes or pathways at any time.

SHOW RULES

General

- Show Management reserves the right to:
 - Refuse or limit entries
 - Combine, divide, split or cancel classes
 - Remove any horse or person from the grounds
 - Interpret all questions regarding rules and conditions
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, discourtesy toward officials or staff, or failure to comply with competition rules may result in disqualification and removal from the competition grounds without refund.
- VHSA membership is not required.
- TIP numbers must be provided to the show secretary prior to the start of your division.
- All riders must complete the online hold harmless form.
- There will be a \$10 grounds fee for non-stabled horses.
- Event policies adhere to USEF Safe Sport requirements.
- A medic will be on site; all rider falls must be evaluated by medical personnel.
- Returned checks will incur a fee and/or be charged to the credit card on file; open checks may not remain on file.
- No credit card processing fees are charged.

Entries

- Show Management reserves the right to limit the number of entries accepted in any division or class.
- Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis according to date and time stamp until the desired number is reached in each division or class.
- Show Management reserves the right to vary the number accepted in each division or class in order to achieve the desired overall entry count.
- All entries will initially be submitted in pending status until reviewed by Show Management. A non-refundable office fee of \$30 will be charged at the time of entry. Accepted entries will then be processed in order of receipt.
- Wait list entries will not incur additional charges until accepted into competition.
- Entries received after the closing date will be accepted only if time and space permit and will incur a \$50 late fee.
- Unjudged jumper rounds are \$25 and will be permitted at the discretion of the judge.

Division/Class Add/Scratches

- Adds and scratches must be completed online or in the show office by 4:00 p.m. the day prior to the class. Day of add/scratch needs to be requested at the show office and approved by Show Management.
- No credit will be issued for scratches made at the ingate or after the class has begun.
- Judge's cards will be used as the official record to determine class attendance and competition participation. Judge's cards shall be considered final and non-disputable.

Entry Scratches

- Office fees are non-refundable.
- Stall fees will be refunded only for horses scratched prior to the closing date of stabling. After the reservation cutoff date, stall fees are non-refundable.

SHOW RULES

Stabling

- Stall fees will be refunded only for horses scratched prior to the closing date of stabling. After the reservation cutoff date, stall fees are non-refundable.
- Stabling must be requested in advance and is available until the Tuesday prior to the show. After Tuesday, any stabling requests are subject to Show Management approval and availability.
- Please email eqoffice@morvenpark.org and clearly indicate the number of horse stalls and tack stalls needed.
- Trainers are encouraged to utilize barn accounts to coordinate and organize their clients' stabling requests.
- Shaving orders are also due by Tuesday prior to the show; additional shavings may be purchased at the show office.
- All stalls are the same rate whether used as horse stalls, tack stalls, or day stalls. Cleaning fees are included in stall pricing.
- Stabled competitors will receive an email from Show Management the week of the show to coordinate.

Close Out Fees

- Exhibitors are responsible for reviewing their accounts and are strongly encouraged to settle all charges by the end of each competition day to ensure accuracy.
- Any open or unpaid entries will be automatically charged to the credit card on file.
- Any accounts not properly closed will be finalized by Show Management at the amount deemed correct. All such charges are final and not subject to dispute.

Dog Policy

- Dogs are welcome but must remain leashed/confined at all times, and owners are responsible for cleaning up after them.

Rider Safety

- Rider may not enter the ring with cell phones or any other communication devices.
- ATSM/SEI approved helmets are required whenever mounted on the competition grounds.

Golf Carts

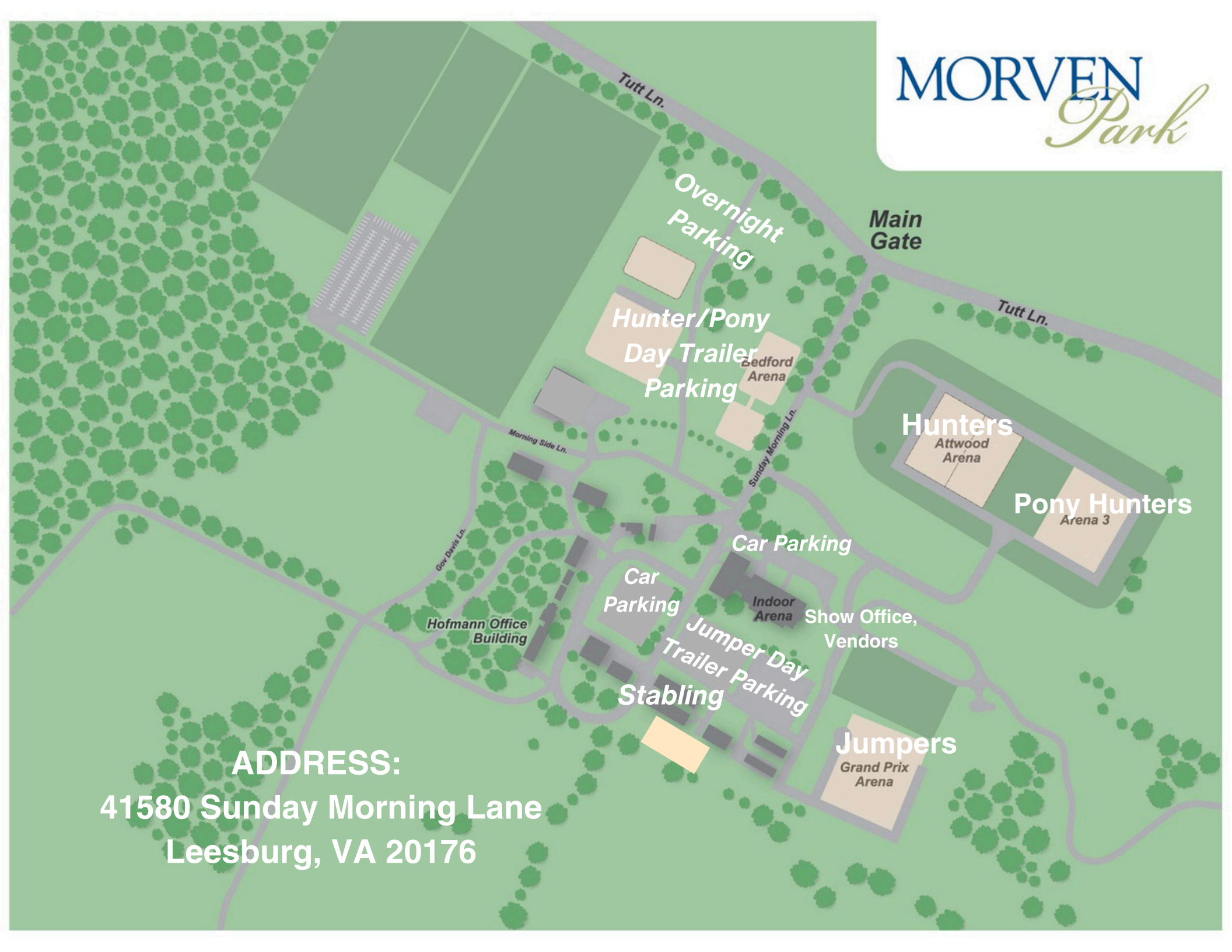
- Golf cart reservations are due by the Tuesday preceding the show closing date.
